Circle of Life / Medicine Wheel Handout

Here are some of the interpretations of the Circle of Life or medicine wheel (note that different Ojibwe bands may have slightly different spellings for the same words):

4 DIRECTIONS

East - Waabanong South - Zhaawanong West - Ningaabi'anong North - Giiwedinong

4 COLORS

East - Yellow - Ozaawaa South - Red - Miskwaa West - Black - Makadewaa North - White - Waabishkaa

4 SEASONS

East - Spring - Ziigwan South - Summer - Niibin West - Autumn - Dagwaagin North - Winter - Biboon

4 TIMES OF DAY

East - Mooka'am - Sunrise South - Naawakwe - High Noon West - Bangishimo - Sunset North - Dibikad - Night

4 BASIC ELEMENTS

East - Water - Nibi South - Wind - Noodin West - Earth - Aki North - Fire - Ishkode

4 HILLS (stages) OF MAN

East - Childhood - Binoojiinhsag South - Adolescence - Shki niigi West - Adult - Gitziimak North - Elder - Gchi epiitzjiik

4 PHASES OF HEALTH

East - Physical South - Social West - Intellectual North - Spiritual

4 NATURES OF MAN

East - Physical South - Emotional West - Mental North - Spiritual

4 GRANDFATHERS / GRANDMOTHERS

East - Beginning - Waabinong South - Going Along - Zhaawinong West - Getting Settled - Epngishmok North - Going Home - Giiwednong

4 SACRED PLANTS

East - Tobacco (Prayer, renewal of life) - Semaa South - Cedar (Courage, cleansing, growth, express feelings) – Giizhik West - Sage (Purifies, introspection, direction, we go when we change worlds in death) - Mmuskode-washk North - Sweetgrass (Invites in good) - Wiingashk

4 RACES OF MAN - The 4 Brothers

East – Yellow (Asian) - Niibiish aabooke ininwag (or Aniibiishaabookewinini) South - Red (Ojibwe) - Anishinaabek (or Anishinaabeg) West - Black (African American) -Mkade ininwag (or makadewiiyaas) North - White (Caucasian) -Zhaaganaashag
